Wednesday 25th November, 2015 at 7.00 p.m.**

**Invitation to members of the public to speak prior to meeting regarding items on the Agenda
(10 minutes allowed for this item)**

Mr Harry Sandercock spoke and offered his support for any decisions made by the Parish Council with regard to the budget for the following year, and acknowledged the hard work the members of the council put in as volunteers. This was agreed by the other members of the public present.

Cllr. Hodge asked those members of the public present if they would be happy with an increase in council tax, and all present said yes. A general discussion ensued.

AGENDA

Precept 2016/17 – to discuss and agree the budget and set the Precept for 2016/17.

The budget sheet was discussed line by line and budgets agreed for 2016/17.

Following on from the decision to acquire the public toilets at Trebarwith Strand and Trevena Square, it was proposed by Cllr. Wickett, seconded by David Hodge and RESOLVED to set a budget of £45,000 for the public conveniences. Three in favour, 2 against. Carried.

It was proposed by Cllr. Wickett, seconded by Cllr. Hodge and RESOLVED to bring the budget amount for the public conveniences to the Parish meeting on the 2nd December, 2015 for approval. All in favour. Carried.

There being no further business, the chairman closed the meeting at 9;10pm.
