Minutes of the Extraordinary meeting of Tintagel Parish Council
Wednesday 23rd March 2016 at 7.00 p.m.

Present: Cllrs. Dyer, Wickett, Flower, Soutter, Hart, Dale & Brooks

Apologies: Cllrs. Goward, Dorman & Hodge

Six members of the public were present.

Declarations of Interest: none

Invitation to members of the public to speak prior to meeting regarding items on the Agenda (10 minutes allowed for this item).

A member of the public spoke to view his concerns with regard to the public toilets at Trebarwith Strand and Trevena Square's possible closure. The gentleman quoted several reasons for keeping the toilets open including elderly people, and people who suffer with Irritable Bowel Syndrome needing access to public toilets.

Planning Applications

PA16/02155 – non-material amendment for omission of work to the Visitors Centre other than improving the entrance to the member's room. Adjusting external finishes and amending details to the link bridge to planning application PA14/05729. Tintagel Castle, Castle Road, Tintagel. Ms Ann Towers, English Heritage.

It was proposed by Cllr. Hart, seconded by Cllr. Brooks and RESOLVED that no objection be made to this application. All in favour.

Public conveniences at Trevena Square Tintagel and Trebarwith Strand:

The clerk informed the meeting that an £8,500 grant had been obtained from the Devolution fund towards the repairs and maintenance of the toilets, and also the County Council will provide the coin entry machines for the toilets. These measures would only apply if the Parish Council decide to take on the freeholds of the toilets. The County Council will also provide another building survey for comparison to the one the Parish Council commissioned.

A discussion ensued with regard to signing the County Council's Tenancy at Will for the toilets during the interim period, whilst the legal meetings were taking place for the viability of taking on the transfers of the freeholds for the toilets.

The clerk read out an email from Cllr. Hodge (who could not attend the meeting) which informed the meeting that a sub-committee had been formed to address the legal options of the transfers of the freeholds. The sub-committee will consist of Cllrs. Wickett, Flower, Dale and Hodge. Cllr. Hodge's email to the meeting is available on request from the Parish Clerk.

It was proposed by Cllr. Flower, seconded by Cllr. Hart and RESOLVED that the Parish Council would sign the tenancies of the toilets in order to keep them open for the season, and the clerk to write to the County Council to advise them of the Parish Council's position at this time as informed by the email from the sub-committee.

The clerk advised that someone will be needed to lock up the toilets at Trebarwith as from the date of the tenancies. Cllr. Hart will look into this. Cllrs. Dyer and Soutter will arrange to collect the keys and meter readings.

There being no further business, the meeting closed at 7:45pm.
